discussion starters. November 1st. | God is...Abounding in Love

We invite you to take the content of our Sunday Morning worship hour, and discuss with a friend, your family, or your LIFEgroup each week. This is meant to be a guide for your discussions and can be used as a launching point or complete study outline. SUMMARY.

God's love never gives up. What we think of God shapes the way we walk, talk, think, love, & move. God is abounding in loyal-love. His loyal-love is not dependent on our faithfulness, God abounds in loyal love, Hesed & Emeth, because of who He is. Jesus showed us what Yahweh's loyal love in action looks like, regardless of your faithfulness, regardless of your loyalty, of your sin, Yahweh is abounding in love & faithfulness, in Hesed & Emet. Because Jesus, who is fully God & Human, was loyal & faithful to God & gave His life on the cross, we can look forward to & have the confident hope of the day when Jesus returns, death & evil will be defeated, & we'll be set free to live with & love God forever. As followers of Jesus, the same must be said of us. - If the world is going to believe in a God who is abounding in loyal love, a love not dependent on how good you are, then they need to see this love lived out in the people of God.
